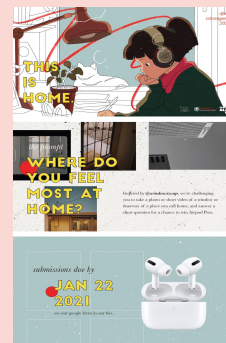

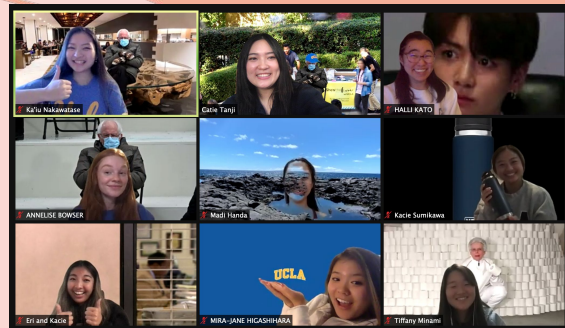

- **Lono: God of Agriculture, fertility & peace**

- Origin Birth: Tahiti [Honua-Mea]
- Notorious for her countless lovers, infidelities and feuds and heated outbursts
  - Fire temper and wrath fire
  - Creator of Hawaii

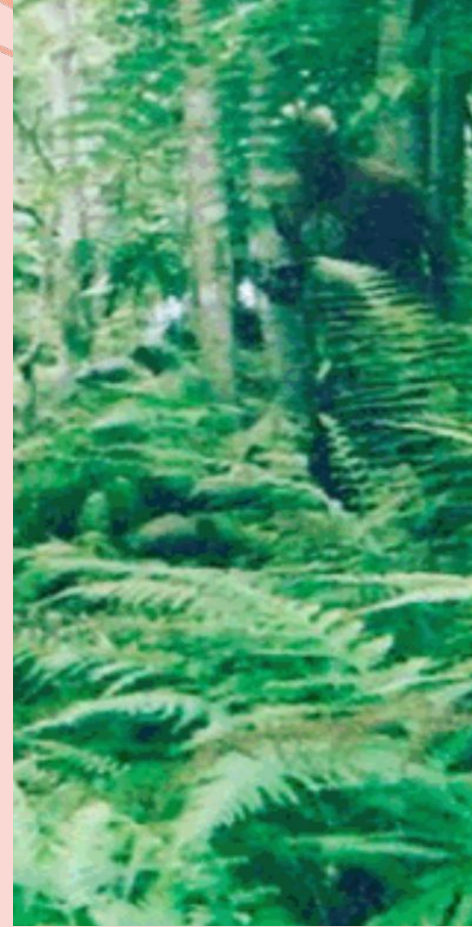
"Molokai 1978, working pineapple fields night shift, our labor truck die out pauhana, they are there, no even take pork across the bridge, I never believe until I seen it!"
